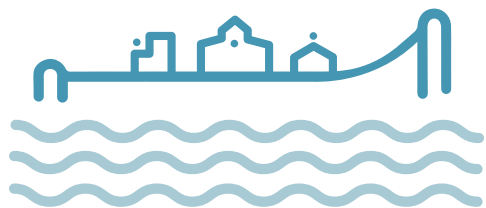

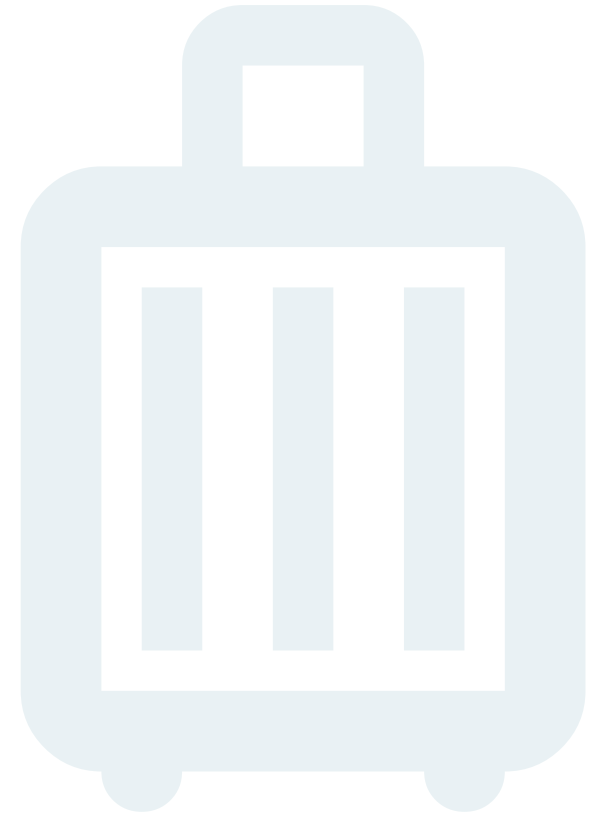

HOW TO REACH BARI

INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AEROPORTO DI BARI KAROL WOJTYLA

Bari Airport (IATA: BRI, ICAO: LIBD), also known as Bari Palese Airport, is a large airport in Italy.

It is an international airport and serves the area of Apulia”, “Bari Province, Italy.

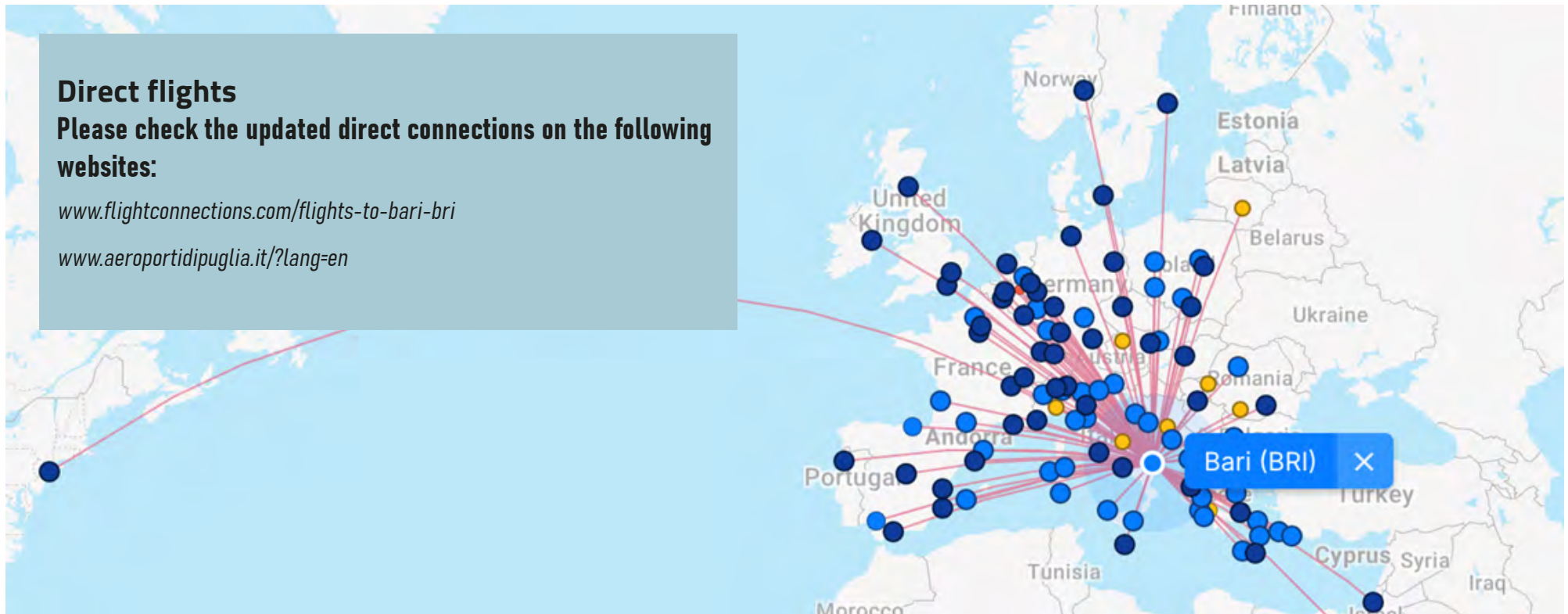
Bari Airport has non-stop passenger flights scheduled to 104 destinations in 32 countries.

At present, there are 19 domestic flights from Bari.

The longest flight from Bari BRI is a 2,788 mile (4,487 km) non-stop route to New York City JFK. This direct flight takes around 9 hours and 15 minutes and is operated by Neos.

Bari airport have 6.000.000 passengers per year.

Situated some 15 km northwest of the city centre – 20 minutes by car, 15 minutes by train.



Airlines using this airport*:

In total there are 27 airlines flying from and to Bari. Most flights are operated by one of the following carriers: Luxwing, Scandinavian Airlines, Norwegian, Neos, Iberia, EuroWings Discover, Edelweiss, Brussels Airlines, Airserbia, Wizzair, Vueling, Volotea, Turkish Airlines, Transaviz, Ryanair, Luxair, Ita Airways, Freebird, Eurowings, Easyjet, British Airways, Austrian Airlines, Albawings, Air France, Air Dolomiti, Air Cairo, Aegean.

From airport to Bari centre:

the airport is 13 km from the the city centre.

- **TAXI:** the cost of a taxi ride from Airport to Hotel is about 25,00 euro.
 - **BUS e TRAIN:** direct connection from the airport to Central Station and viceversa
- 🕒 travelling time: 25 / 30 min
- 🎫 ticket Price (One Way): BUS € 4,00 – TRAIN € 5,00)

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

VIA ROME

Rome is approximately 470 km from Bari.

An alternative option is to **fly into Rome Fiumicino Airport** (Leonardo da Vinci International Airport), which is **connected to Rome Termini Central Station** by an internal train service called the Leonardo Express, the journey takes **approximately 32 minutes**. From Rome Termini, there are **direct trains to Bari Centrale Station**, with an average travel time of **approximately 4 to 5 hours**, depending on the type of train (Frecciarossa or Intercity).

VIA BOLOGNA

Bologna is approximately 670 km from Bari. Bologna Guglielmo Marconi **Airport is connected to Bologna Centrale Railway Station** by the **Marconi Express**, an automated monorail service. The journey takes **approximately 7 minutes**.

VIA BRINDISI

Brindisi is located approximately 115 km from Bari. If you fly into Brindisi Salento Airport, you can take a **short shuttle bus** (operated by STP Brindisi) **from the airport to Brindisi Centrale Railway Station**. The shuttle ride takes about 10–15 minutes and runs frequently throughout the day. From Brindisi Centrale, there are **direct regional and Intercity trains to Bari Centrale Station**, with a travel time of **approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes to 1 hour and 30 minutes**, depending on the train type.

OTHER MEANS OF TRANSPORT

BY TRAINS

Trenitalia runs Alta Velocità high-speed trains to Puglia's main cities. Daily services run from Turin, Milan, Venice and Rome to Foggia, Bari, Brindisi, Lecce and Taranto. As a rule, trains to Lecce generally stop at Foggia, Barletta, Bari, Ostuni and Brindisi. Within the region, Trenitalia and several local companies run slower intercity and regional trains to most towns and cities.
