Jazzoo & Jazzoo 2 – Artistic workshop with Oddjob

In the workshop, Oddjob uses musical themes from Jazzoo's concert and involves the children in different ways through letting them interpretate and create music. The workshop also gives an introduction to the characteristics of Jazz music and to the different instruments that are played.

Associations to music

One of the elements in the workshop consists of Oddjob playing excerpts from the songs "The Duck" and "The Kangaroo" letting the children give suggestions of animals that they come to think of when listening to the music. "The Duck" and "The Kangaroo" are then performed with animations.

Presentation of the instruments

The musicians introduce their instruments and demonstrate how they can sound. The presentation transitions into "The Elephant" which is performed with animations.

Jazz and improvisation

A short introduction to Jazz as a musical style and how you can express and recognize feelings through music. We demonstrate some examples of feelings that "the Duck" can experience. The children are

then invited to suggest different feelings and the band makes improvised interpretations of these together with animations.

Ending 1. Alternative with drawing

Oddjob plays for example "The polarbear and the whale" and "The squirrel" while the children make drawings from the associations that they get from the music.

Ending 2. Alternative with rhythm

The children are introduced to a rhythm and participate as a rhythm and voice section in "The Hippo" or "The Penguin" which is performed together with animations.
